<u>PETITION UNDER I.C. 35-33-10-3(4) TO THE GOVERNOR, STATE OF INDIANA</u>

The Defendant, by counsel, respectfully petitions the Honorable [insert governor's name],
Governor, State of Indiana, to investigate the demand for the Defendant's extradition, to order a report
prepared concerning the situation and circumstances of the Defendant, and to determine whether the

When a Defendant is arrested without a warrant, the judge must determine "that the person held is the person charged with having committed the crime alleged and that he probably committed the crime, and except in cases arising under subjection 7 of this section, that he has fled from jurisdiction. . " I.C. 35-33-10-3 (15) (16). The issue of whether the Defendant "probably" committed the charged crime is pending before the
