ORDER

This Court, having considered Defendant's Offer of Stipulations and Motion in Limine Regarding Evidence of Defendant's Prior Criminal History, and duly advised in the premises, now finds that the motion should be GRANTED.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Court that (1) the State is to accept Defendant's proposed stipulations; (2) the State, through its prosecutors and witnesses, shall not mention, refer to, interrogate about, or attempt to convey to the jury in any manner, either directly or indirectly, any documentary or testimonial evidence regarding Defendant's prior criminal convictions without the permission of this Court, outside the presence and hearing of the jury; and (3) the State and its witnesses shall not make any reference to the fact that the Defendant's motion in limine has been filed and granted.
